In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (s) of section 2 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Central Act 2 of 1974) read with section 5 of the Kerala Police Act, 2011 (8 of 2011), and in partial modification of the notification issued under G.O. (Rt) No. 889/2015/Home dated 10th April, 2015 and published as S.R.O. No. 215/2015 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 836 dated 16th April, 2015, in so far as it relates to the area



and location of the Meenakshipuram Police Station, the Government of Kerala hereby declare that the Building No. 746 Ward No. XI, Sy No. 230/II, Perumatti Grama Panchayath, Moolathara Village, Chittur Taluk, Palakkad District shall be a Police Station known as “Meenakshipuram Police Station”.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Meenakshipuram Police Station is now functioning in a rented Building No. 10/92, situated in Survey No. 251/I/I PT. 251/51 in Perumatti Grama Panchayat, Moolathara Village, Chittur Taluk, Palakkad District. A new building, bearing No.746, Ward No. XI, Sy. No. 230/II, Perumatti Grama Panchayath, Moolathara Village, Chittur Taluk, Palakkad District has been constructed for housing this Police Station. Government have decided to shift the functioning of Meenakshipuram Police Station to the newly constructed building.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
